## 2025 Back to the Bricks® Scholarship Guidelines

Back to the Bricks<sup>®</sup> is planning to award a total of \$10,000 in post-secondary scholarships for 2025.

## **SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES:**

- 1. The Back to the Bricks® Scholarship Program provides assistance to high school seniors in Flint and Genesee County who are pursuing post-secondary study/training at a college or technical school in auto-body repair/painting, automotive design, auto mechanics, electrical/manufacturing/mechanical engineering, robotics, sales and marketing, software development for automotive applications, welding, or a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) related program.
- 2. All applications must be towards attending a post-secondary accredited school.
- 3. Preference is given to applicants attending a local college, university, technical school or institution, but not required.
- 4. Students in Flint and Genesee County already enrolled into a post-secondary program may apply but must be in good academic standing with the school they are currently enrolled in.
- 5. All applicants shall include an essay from 200-500 words on why they should be granted a scholarship. We encourage each applicant to include a personal accounting as to how the automotive industry or hobby has impacted their lives.
- 6. Scholarships will be on a 'one-time' basis.
- 7. If available, each application should include a family personal financial statement (FASFA).
- 8. Include at least one letter of recommendation with your application.
- 9. Each application shall include a transcript of grades (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades for high school applicants and for those already enrolled into a post-secondary school a current transcript of their grades).
- 10. The scholarship may be used for tuition and fees.
